WHEREAS, SLCGP allows entities to address cybersecurity risks and cybersecurity threats to information systems owned or operated by, or on behalf of, state, local, or tribal government; and,

WHEREAS, The SLCGP grant will fund training and software to promote an increase in cybersecurity, preparedness, and mitigation efforts for the City of New Haven, specifically, the Board of Education and local institution of academia.
