Re: Multi-Year Agreement with Severin Intermediate Holdings LLC, for PowerSchool Student Information System Software and Subscription Licenses

Dear Honorable Tyisha Walker-Myers:

I respectfully submit the enclosed to request the approval of the Board of Alders for the agreement between the New Haven Public Schools and Severin Intermediate Holdings LLC for PowerSchool system from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2030. PowerSchool is a software student information system (SIS) program that helps New Haven Public Schools to manage and streamline various administrative and academic processes (e.g. - tracking student attendance, grades, schedules, academic performance, transportation, health, etc.). With its web-based platform, PowerSchool allows educators to input and access real-time data, support personalized learning, and help administrators make data-driven decisions to improve educational outcomes for our students.

In addition, the district is purchasing the following PowerSchool subscriptions (Perform, Registration, and Ecollect). These subscriptions enable families to access an electronic form collection system for student registration system, administration needs, scheduling, attendance, state compliance reporting, data management, faculty management, emergency/medical and health management, registration, and gradebooks. The Enrollment Registration allows parents to complete registration forms online in both English and Spanish. United Talent Perform is our educator evaluation system.

Thank you for considering this agreement, which will provide better value at lower cost than that currently in place. It is fiscally responsible for the district budget and city taxpayers.
