Dear President Walker-Myers:

In accordance with the Order of New Haven Board of Alders (Board) authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept all grants on behalf of the City of New Haven (City), passed on 17 October 1994, I write to respectfully request the Honorable Board of Alders to authorize the Mayor of the City of New Haven to apply for and accept the Per Capita Grant Award from the Connecticut Department of Public Health and to execute, acknowledge, implement and deliver any and all documents as may be considered necessary or appropriate with respect thereto. This application is required annually to continue public health emergency response initiatives. As this application is for a continuation in funding, we are seeking **unanimous consent**.

With these funds, the New Haven Health Department will support core public health infrastructure and essential service delivery, including maintenance of electronic medical record (EMR) and billing systems, program administration, and operational capacity to ensure continuity of care. Funding will strengthen data management, reporting, and overall efficiency in delivering population-based services aligned with state and local public health priorities. A more detailed description of the program is provided in the Executive Summary. Program administration and services are provided by the New Haven Health Department.
