Funding request: \$100,000, from December 5, 2025, through December 5, 2027

The Department of Community Resilience is seeking a violence prevention research and capacity building grant from the Kaiser Permanente Center for Gun Violence Research and Education in collaboration with Health Alliance for Violence Intervention. This funding opportunity was released on August 2, 2025. With this funding opportunity of up to \$100,000, the Office of Violence Prevention under the Department of Community Resilience in partnership with Yale New Haven Hospital would be able to continue its collaborative partnerships with community-based organizations that are deeply engrained within New Haven and build upon capacity that is significantly necessary to the continue the work. The overarching goal of this funding opportunity is to support researchers and organizations investigating health-focused approaches to address gun violence, who work closely with communities affected by gun violence and work amongst our partners to take a criminal violence intervention and public health approach to reducing gun violence, crime and victimization.
