Other Comments: The federal grant is considered an earmark, which was applied for as part of the FY24 budget process and was awarded via the K-12 Congressionally Funded Community Projects, Innovation and Improvement Account as administered by the US Department of Education. This \$1.5M grant, together with a \$1.5M ARP Career Pathways allocation are being made available to NHPS to cover operational costs and articulation agreements with Southern and Gateway that may be associated with BioCity. A key cost driver is the start up costs for capital and lab equipment. Ongoing costs include the monthly operating charges for the BioLabs space, consistent with other tenants in the incubator, as well as "consumables" for science experiments and classwork. The goal is to operate the program for three academic years and, following 'proof-of-concept' align BioCity with other workforce development funding sources for long-term sustainability.
