I continue to see elevated lead levels in children at a rate that has not significantly decreased in the nearly 10 years I have worked as a general pediatrician in New Haven. Part of my duty to help families and children is to also address the larger environmental and social causes of poor health. By serving on the city's lead poisoning advisory committee, I hope I can foster a connection between city efforts to improve lead abatement and the clinicians who care for the families impacted by lead poisoning.

Why are you interested in serving on a board or commission?

My responsibility to my patients is not limited to the encounters we have in the examination room. Having a greater understanding the various initiatives and coordinated efforts amongst city agencies responsible for lead education and abatement will also help the community of physicians who care for these families. I hope I can bring to the committee a better understanding of how lead impacts New Haven children, and in turn, I'd like to share what I learn about city-wide lead abatement efforts to other clinicians so they can take better care of their patients.

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Why do you believe you would be a good fit for your selected board and commission(s)?

I actually think there may be more qualified physicians to serve on this committee -- namely, Dr. Erin Nozetz, who is the associate director of the Yale Lead Toxicity Clinic (please, reinvite her to join!) My qualifications include having taken care of many children who have been affected by lead toxicity; being able to communicate to a large base of pediatricians and clinicians who care for children in the greater New Haven area and at Yale Health; and simply having the time to be prepared and serve on a committee that does such work.
