Subject: 4(f) Coordination – Kimberly Field

City of New Haven

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) met with Mr. Sandeep Aysola, Director of Transportation, Traffic & Parking, Mr. Bijan Notghi, Deputy Director of Traffic Operations, as well as other City of New Haven (City) representatives to review the preliminary design of the subject project. Minor grading impacts, reconstruction of the existing driveway, and temporary construction easements behind the back of proposed sidewalk at Kimberly Field were presented and determined to have no adverse effects to the activities, features, or attributes of the park. Coordination for the proposed project between the CTDOT and representatives of the City has been ongoing.

The purpose of this project is to improve the safety and traffic operations at the Route 10 and Kimberly Avenue intersection, as well as along State Route 745 (S.R. 745). The project is critical because of the high number of crashes within the project limits.

The CTDOT held a public information meeting on September 25, 2024, at the Betsy Ross Arts Magnet School (150 Kimberly Ave.) in New Haven. The meeting was well attended and there were no objections to the proposed improvements, and no concerns were expressed relating to the property uses listed above at Kimberly Field. The public also had the opportunity to provide written comments after the meeting. No comments were received pertaining to the uses to Kimberly Field.
