Meetin Minutes

*Alder Marchand, Chair called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m., October 22, 2025, in the Aldermanic Chamber, 165 Church Street, New Haven. Present were Aids. Marchand, Walker-Myers, Hamilton, Festa, and Punzo.*

**2. ORDER TO READ AND FILE THE UPDATED BUDGETARY AND FINANCIAL REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2025 IN COMPLIANCE WITH ARTICLE VIII SECTION 5 OF THE CHARTER.**

*Shannon McCue, Director of the office of Policy, Management, and grants, and Ron Gizzi, from OPMG, came before the committee. Ms. McCue spoke about the August Monthly Financial Report.*

*Alder Furlow to have the 3.6-million-dollar savings from the bonding be explained. Ms. McCue explained this savings.*

*Alder Furlow asked if there were any credits from utility bills. Ms. McCue explained.*

*Alder Furlow asked if other projects could be eligible for ARPA funds. Ms. McCue explained.*

*Alder Furlow how the shortages/overages were listed within the departments. Ms. McCue explained.*

*Alder Furlow asked if they could get a copy of the department breakdown. Ms. McCue said they could.*

*No further questions were asked.*

*Alder Marchand asked three times if anyone from the public wished to testify. No one*

*came forward.*

*Alder Marchand told the committee that they were not voting on these items because the committee did not have a quorum present and that he was going to ask that these items be discharged at the next Board of Alders meeting and be voted on.*

*At 7:45 PM, on a motion by Festa seconded by Punzo, the Committee voted to close the meeting.*
