Approval of the Tentative Agreement for the Successor Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of New Haven and AFSCME Local 1303-464 (Attorney Union) dated July 1, 2020 Through June 30, 2026.

2. Reason why item cannot be placed on the Regular Agenda of the next Board of Aldermen meeting (in approximately two weeks):

The Union ratified the tentative agreement on April 14, 2023, requiring OLR to submit the package on the regular agenda by April 6, 2023, for the April 17th full Board meeting. The April 6th deadline did not allow Labor Relations and Finance to prepare the package in time for regular agenda, and it is bound by the 45-day statutory timeline for legislative approval. If Labor Relations waited until the next Board meeting on May 1st, the Board would not have enough time to act on the submission prior to the 45-day timeline.
