PURPOSE OF PROGRAM: To address significant tree canopy loss across Connecticut to pests and disease, as well as provide funding to remove trees that are dead, hazardous, or declining due to invasive insects and disease, and to plant replacement trees.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF CITY'S PROPOSAL: The city's proposal will request funding to remove high risk trees that have been inspected by an arborist in low canopy neighborhoods. The replacement trees species and locations will be selected by the Tree System Coordinator with the purpose of growing canopy in areas of highest need, as well as increase urban forest health and resilience.

MATCH REQUIREMENT FROM GENERAL FUND (if any): General Fund City staff will be used for in-kind services such as tree maintenance and tree establishment.
