



Dennis W. Daniels' Employment Bio

Dennis W. Daniels is the President/Chief Executive Officer for Project M.O.R.E., Inc. He came to Project MORE after spending 30 years with the City of New Haven Department of Fire Service, where he spent 10 years with administrative managerial experience, the last four years as the Chief of Department overseeing 400 department members with a \$22 million budget. Having served in the military during the Viet Nam era as a Ground Radio Operator in the United States Air Force, he was Honorably Discharge as a Sergeant. Mr. Daniels served on the Board of Directors of Project MORE since 1978, later becoming Chairman in 2007 before being named President/CEO in 2009. During the time being at the helm, five new programs have been added in Poughkeepsie, NY; the establishment of the Roger Everson Independent Living House; the restoration of Project READ, a GED program and Project MORE Diaper Bank program for both clients and the community bringing a total number of programs in New Haven and Poughkeepsie to fifteen programs being managed in helping clients reintegrate themselves back into their communities.
