The 8th Annual New Haven Chalk Art Festival will take place on Saturday, Oct. 11, 2025, from 12-4pm (rain date Oct. 12) in an expanded location in the Broadway District. The event will span Broadway Island, the Broadway Civil War Monument Park, and a small section of Elm St. with a street closure, creating one vibrant, interconnected location. Over 65 professional and amateur artists will draw their chalk artwork onto the street along Elm St. (between Park St. and the stop sign near TYCO) and on Broadway Island. Free activations and entertainment will include a live band (positioned in the Broadway Civil War Monument Park), special shopping offers, complimentary kettle corn, free crafts & face painting, a Family Fun Zone (in the courtyard behind Apple and The Yale Bookstore), and much more.
