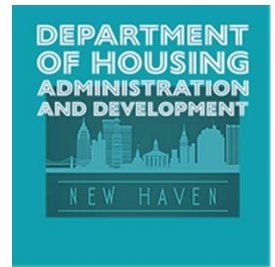

Re: 2026 Neighborhood Assistance Act Program

Dear President Walker-Myers:

I am pleased to submit a list of non-profit organizations seeking eligibility to receive donations under the State of Connecticut 2026 Neighborhood Assistance Act (NAA). In accordance with Chapter 228a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, this list must be presented to the Board before submission to the Commissioner of Revenue Services. The deadline for submitting proposals to the Department of Revenue Services is **July 1, 2026**.

The Neighborhood Assistance Act is a tax credit program administered by the Connecticut Department of Revenue Services, designed to encourage corporations to support community programs through charitable donations. The City of New Haven serves as a liaison between local non-profit organizations and the State, ensuring proper coordination and facilitation of this process.

Therefore, I respectfully request that the Honorable Board of Alders authorize the Mayor to submit all necessary documents to the State of Connecticut Department of Revenue Services to fulfill the program requirements.
