

BACKGROUND

The State of Connecticut Department of Transportation District 3 Maintenance is located at 140 Pond Lily Avenue. The Department of Transportation, in seeking to build electric vehicle charging stations and has offered to purchase the northerly side of Pond Lily Avenue to facilitate this project. The proposal is total of 2,159 Square Feet of land being purchased for the price of \$4,875.00. This offer is based upon the State's Estimate of Compensation. The property map and proposed plan for the EV charging stations are in your materials and shown below.



PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

Based on the preceding considerations and specific findings, the proposed easement is found to be in accord with the comprehensive plans of the City of New Haven.

New Haven Vision 2025, Summary of Recommendations, xxiii: "Grow sustainable transportation systems by assessing the capacity of existing transportation systems in relation to the density and intensity of uses proposed in new developments."

While electric vehicle (EV) charging is not specifically mentioned in the current comprehensive plan, the City is working toward increasing EV infrastructure and capacity to accommodate future demands for EV charging.

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The Commission recommends approval of the Disposition.
