PURPOSE OF PROGRAM: To support small-scale, non-infrastructure projects that improve conditions for people walking, biking, and rolling by advancing equitable, safe, accessible, and sustainable active transportation options.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF CITY'S PROPOSAL: The City of New Haven intends to apply for funding through the CTDOT Active Transportation Microgrant Program administered by SCRCOG. The City may use grant funds to procure eligible non-infrastructure equipment, materials, and safety resources that support walking, biking, and rolling within the community. Eligible items include equipment and materials such as bicycle parking, safety gear, bicycle maintenance resources, and pedestrian and bicycle safety education materials. These improvements support the City's ongoing efforts to expand safe and accessible transportation options for residents and visitors.

ALLOWABLE INDIRECT COST: Not applicable. Any minor administrative or operational costs associated with program implementation will be absorbed through existing departmental resources.
