The State of Connecticut Department of Transportation is responsible for the administration of the Construction project replacing the West River Bridge for I-95. As part of the project, the CT DOT undertook various work on local roads, and the agreement before you formalizes the acceptance of the improvements done by the CT DOT. The City of New Haven continues to maintain its local roads under the agreement, along with the improvements undertaken by the CT DOT.

Funding for this project was provided by the Surface Transportation Program and was undertaken with eighty percent (80%) federal funds and twenty percent (20%) State funds. No City funds were utilized for this project.
