Please move forward with the proposed Civilian Review Board (CRB) governance changes. The current system lacks transparency and is broken. We cannot — must not — rely solely on the New Haven Police Department (NHPD) Internal Affairs division to conduct its investigation before the CRB can become involved.

My district currently has a case being investigated by Internal Affairs. While they take their time, an officer accused of a serious breach of the public's trust is being transferred to another district. When I asked an assistant chief if it is common practice to transfer officers who are under investigation, he said that the chief of police allows it unless there is a serious problem. The officer in question is accused of pressuring the victim of a hit and run not to "file a complaint" and helping an elected official cover up his illegal behavior. (Note: The officer has a record of violating department policies.)

My neighbors and I should not have to wait for the CRB to be involved. Please make the proposed changes to allow the CRB to act swiftly and make Internal Affairs investigations more TRANSPARENT!
