Dear President Walker-Myers,

On Behalf of the Office of Emergency Management, I am submitting for your consideration and approval a resolution giving the Mayor of New Haven permission to apply for and accept the 2020 FEMA Assistance for Firefighters Grant (AFG). We respectfully request your honorable board's approval.

Previous Assistance for Firefighters Grants have allowed the City to replace antiquated equipment, such as pumper and engines, rehab units, and washers and extractors.

With the 2020 Assistance to Firefighters Grant, we hope to receive federal funding of \$1,423,175.45 to purchase 166 Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) for NHFD personnel. The NHFD is currently utilizing **SCBA** that has exceeded its life expectancy for a metropolitan fire department. They were also purchased with a FEMA AFG Award in 2009. These SCBA units are costing the Fire Department thousands of dollars in maintenance and repairs.

Also included is a new Air re-filling Station. This equipment is paramount to provide NHFD with the latest NFPA standards for Breathing Apparatus.

If awarded, there is a 10% match of \$142,317.55 which will come from the Fire Departments Capital Budget for equipment that is already in the plans to be purchased.
