The state of Connecticut is facing a solid waste disposal crisis, as hundreds of thousands of tons of waste are shipped out of state each year to be landfilled. The City and its Solid Waste and Recycling Authority have a leading role to play in addressing the waste crisis - the efficient operation of the transfer station, improved recycling, and new opportunities for diverting other materials such as food waste and fuel canisters can all help to reduce our impact on the environment and lessen residents' tax burdens. I've enjoyed my time as a member of the New Haven Solid Waste and Recycling Authority team and would be excited to continue working on these issues with fellow commissioners and staff.

I have always had a strong interest in reducing waste and improving recycling and later in life became interested in composting and food rescue.
