I am submitting for your review and approval the following list of uncollected tax accounts for transfer to the Suspense Tax Book.

Connecticut General Statute, Section 12-165 requires the Tax Collector, at least once a year, to request reclassifications as suspense items, those accounts for which collections are not anticipated. This reclassification is in accordance with prudent financial management as it takes a conservative approach to estimating the tax receivable. It should however be stated clearly, that for any accounts so transferred, the Tax Office does not cease to collect on said accounts.
