Dear President Walker-Myers:

In accordance with the Order of New Haven Board of Alders (Board) authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept all grants on behalf of the City of New Haven (City), passed on 17 October 1994, I write to respectfully request the Honorable Board of Alders to authorize the Mayor of the City of New Haven to transfer \$2,300,000 from the Health Department's general fund salary line (13011010-50110) to the Health Departments Miscellaneous line (13011010-56699) to increase the amount of the contract with Worldwide Traveling Staff, Inc. by \$2,300,000 to cover the total estimated costs for the provision of temporary nursing services in New Haven schools for the period of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025 and to execute, acknowledge, implement, and deliver any and all documents as may be considered necessary or appropriate with respect thereto.

Through this contract, Worldwide Travel Staffing, Inc. will provide nursing services in New Haven public schools and the Health Department clinic to ensure continuity of services for students and the community.
