Meeting Minutes

Alder Marchand, Chair called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m., September 28, 2023, in the Aldermanic Chamber, 165 Church Street, New Haven. Present were Alds. Marchand, Douglass, DeCola, Morrison, Festa, Furlow, and Singh.

Michael Gormany, Acting City Controller, Marcela Garcia, Manager of Human Resources and Benefits, and Katrina Rush-Kittle, Chief Administrative Officer, came before the committee. Mr. Gormany spoke followed by Ms. Garcia.

Alder Festa asked what changes in testing were being done. Ms. Garcia explained.

Alder Furlow asked why the position changes were not part of the last budget request. Ms. Garcia explained.

Alder Festa asked for an explanation of the title changes. Ms. Garcia went over them.

No further questions were asked.

Alder Marchand asked three times if anyone from the public wished to testify. No one came forward.

Michael Gormany, acting City Controller, and Malinda Figueroa, Purchasing Agent, came before the committee. Mr. Gormany spoke on both items.

Alder Festa asked for clarification of the IT software costs and contract. Mr. Gormany did so.

Alder Douglass asked about the CONCORD number. Ms. Figueroa spoke about this.

Alder Festa asked what effect there would be if they delayed the position until the next budget cycle. Mr. Gormany spoke on this

No further questions were asked.

Alder Marchand asked three times if anyone from the public wished to testify. No one came forward.

At 8:00 PM, Alder Marchand told the committee there would be a short break.

At 8:12 PM, Alder Marchand brought the meeting back to order.

Michael Gormany, Acting City Controller, and Sean Mattison, Mayor's Chief of Staff, came before the committee. Mr. Gormany spoke on the request.

Alder Furlow asked for an explanation of the increases and range changes. Mr. Mattison spoke about them.

Alder Morrison asked if the City had annual performance reviews. Mr. Mattison spoke on this.

Alder Furlow asked if the Administration have a plan to establish annual reviews. Mr. Mattison said he would have to get back to the committee with this information.

Alder Marchand asked about retroactive payments. Mr. Gormany said that he would have to get back on this information.

No further questions were asked.

Alder Marchand asked three times if anyone from the public wished to testify. No one came forward.

Alder Marchand told the committee that items 5 through 8 would be heard together.

Michael Gormany, Acting Controller came before the committee. Mr. Gormany spoke about the July Monthly Financial Report. And the Year End Transfers.

No questions were asked.

Alder Marchand asked three times if anyone from the public wished to testify. No one came forward.

At 9:28 PM, on a motion by DeCola, seconded by Festa, to close the public portion of the meeting. The committee voted unanimously in favor of the motion.

#### Committee Action:

- 1. Alder DeCola, seconded by Festa to move item 1 for discussion. Alders DeCola, Morrison, Festa, Furlow, and Marchand spoke in favor of this item. The committee voted unanimously to approve the reclassification of Hurman Resource positions.
- 2. Alder DeCola, seconded by Festa to move item 2, amendment to Article VII-Budgetary & Financial Administration. Alder Marchand, seconded by DeCola, made a motion to substitute \$25,000 for the \$50,000 threshold. The committee voted by voice vote, Ayes-Alder Morrison, DeCola, Marchand, Douglass, Singh, and Festa., Nays Alder Furlow. The amendment passed. The committee had a discussion on whether the item should be held in committee or sent to the Board of Alders. The committee voted to move the item favorably Aye- Alders Morrison, Marchand, DeCola, Douglass, Nay- Alders Festa, Singh, and Furlow. The item passed.
- 3. Alder DeCola, seconded by Festa to move items 3, The committee voted, by voice vote, with Alder Festa voting No, to approve the Deputy Purchasing Agent and the budget transfer.
- 4. Alder DeCola, seconded by Festa to move items 5, 6, and 7 for Read and File. The committee voted, by voice vote, to unanimously to approve the three-monthly reports for Read and File.
- 5. Alder DeCola, seconded by Festa to move item 8, the Year End Transfer. The committee voted, by voice vote, to unanimously to approve the Year End Transfer.

At 10:25 PM, on a motion by DeCola seconded by Festa, the Committee voted to close the meeting.
