Other Comments: The motion to amend is intended to reflect an updated total project cost, which affects the grant amount being applied for. The original impact to the City was \$1,414,000, with an original total cost of the project is \$4,400,000.

The impact now projected to the City is \$2,822,521. The Department of Administrative Services grant reimbursement rate is 67.86%. The total cost of the project is \$8,781,957. The matching funds will be appropriated from the Board of Education's Capital Funds and the City of New Haven's General Fund.
