Dear Honorable Walker-Myers,

In accordance with the Order of the Board of Alders authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept all grants on behalf of the City of New Haven, passed October 17, 1994, I am respectfully writing to advise the Honorable Board of Alders that the Department of Community Resilience would like to accept a Federal Earmark totaling \$2,000,000 from the Federal Government, which was included in the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 (H.R. 2471).

The funds will be used to fund Crisis Response programs and supports, consistent with applicable federal requirements, including but not limited to the Elm City COMPASS Team (New Haven Crisis Response Team), which will be a team led by mental health professionals who will respond to some 9-1-1 calls for services whenever these calls do not include any medical emergencies, violence or criminal activities.
