It appears there was an error in one of the files I found on your appointments and reappointments, and it looks like what went in as an appointment in 2014 was actually a re-appointment.

This means the Board will not be able to move forward with reappointing you in the packet of documents I submitted for that purpose this month unless there was a year between 2007 and now that you had taken your charter required year off of the Peace Commission.

If you did take the 1 year off as required, can you just put that information in your response email to me here? I will have the email submitted so that when your file goes to Aldermanic Affairs they'll be able to move forward.

If you did not take a year off from Peace Commission between 2007 and now, then they will have you step off as a voting member for 1 year before we could proceed with placing you back on as a voting member. This would mean the current reappointment will be given leave to withdraw, and I could resubmit you for a new appointment in 2023.
