Dear Alder President Walker-Myers,

In accordance with the Order of the Board of Alders authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept all grants on behalf of the City of New Haven, passed October 17, 1994, I am writing to respectfully request that the Honorable Board approve the submission of an application by the City of New Haven's Department of Community Resilience to the U.S. Department of Justice, and to accept such funds if offered and to execute all documents and contracts as necessary. The Department would like to apply for \$2,000,000.00 for a threeyear grant from the Office of Justice Programs: 2022 Community Based Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative.

This important grant will help expand and enhance the work conducted by the New Haven Office of Violence Prevention and community partners.
