

## SCOPE OF SERVICES

Power in a Shower requests funding from the City of New Haven - Office of Housing & Homelessness services totaling \$150,000. Provisions are for approximately 2,500 showers (100 showers per week) in the city of New Haven, Connecticut from July 1, 2023, through June 2026.

Each shower provides individuals with:

- One Hygienic Care Package (toothpaste, toothbrush, lotion, razor, deodorant, hand sanitizer, masks, and wash cloth).
- Disposable bath towels
- Undergarments (as needed)
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Drawstring bags
- T-Shirts, Socks

Each client is afforded 20 minutes of shower time (but no more than 30 minutes). Clients have 10 minutes to undress, shower, then redress.

Power in a Shower, Inc. team staff consists of but not limited to 2 Vehicle Operators,

3 Attendants.

Our reliable staff team members meet and greet all clientele with the utmost courtesy and respect, register each client prior to showering, distribute to each client a hygienic care kit (consisting of undergarments, t-shirts, disposable towel, etc.) clean and disinfect each shower stall in preparation for the next client. Set up and break down mobile showers.

Power in a Shower, Inc., provides a total of (4) shower stalls; (3) stalls with a showering area of 36" x 36" and (1) stall with a showering area of 32" x 48"

Shower stall 32" x 48" is ADA compliant with the following:

- Ramp for wheelchair/disability accessibility.
- Grab bars.
- Shower seats.
- A pressure balanced mixing valve to prevent scalding.
- Height adjustable shower head with a minimum 59" long hose, it can be used as a handheld or as a fixed shower head.
- Clearance space outside the shower to allow for easy approach in a wheelchair.

All (4) shower stalls have face basins and seating - (3) seating areas support a maximum weight of 300 pounds, and (1) seating area supports a maximum weight of 260 pounds. Of the (4) stalls (2) have detachable shower nozzles for convenience while showering.

All locations - Shower Units will be available (4) days per week consisting of 3 mornings and 1 evening, (4) hours each day, for Weekly Estimated Operating Costs total \$5,100. 40% of expenses will cover tangible goods weekly distributed to clients (potential capacity to accommodate 100 showers each week). The remaining 60% of budgeted expenses will cover transportation, mobile shower storage, maintenance costs, repairs, and operational services. (Note - estimated costs exclude applicable taxes or damages).
