## 12-10-19 – Dwight Resident Talking Points

We are calling for the Joint Community Development-Legislation Committee to **VOTE NO on all resolutions, petitions, applications, and orders related to the** Yale-New Haven Hospital Saint Raphael Campus expansion because:

- 1. This project does not have the informed consent of Dwight residents.
  - Notices have only been provided to property owners within 200 feet of the development. Around 70% of this City's residents are tenants. No efforts have been made to notify tenants, who will be the most impacted by this development.
  - Any conversations between the Yale New-Haven Hospital and City leaders with respect to site plans or community benefits must be open to the public and include Dwight residents.
- 2. There is inadequate information on how this development will impact Dwight residents.
  - Yale New-Haven Hospital must conduct an environmental impact study that includes a study on how increased traffic and pollution will impact health outcomes.
  - Yale New-Haven Hospital must conduct a study to show how this expansion will displace current Dwight residents through increased evictions, rent, property taxes, and other changes.
- 3. Once these studies have been conducted and before a vote by this Joint Committee is made, Yale New-Haven Hospital should submit an application that has the informed consent of Dwight residents and addresses the environmental, health, and displacement impacts that this expansion will have.
