

Dear President Walker-Myers,

On Behalf of the Office of Emergency Management, I am submitting for your consideration and approval a resolution giving the Mayor of New Haven permission to apply for and accept the 2020 FEMA Assistance for Firefighters Supplemental Grant. We respectfully request your honorable board's approval.

Previous Assistance to Firefighters Grants have allowed the City to replace antiquated equipment, such as pumpers and engines, rehab units, and gear washers and extractors. This supplemental grant, in addition to the yearly Assistance to Firefighters Grant, aims to assist the City financially in the midst of the pandemic and was specifically developed to help in covering covid-19 related costs.

With the 2020 Assistance to Firefighters Supplemental Grant, we hope to receive federal funding of \$164,873.09 to reimburse the City for purchases of protective coveralls, respirators, eye protection, and gloves for public safety personnel. These necessary purchases of personal protective equipment (PPE) has enabled our Firefighters and Police to properly protect themselves during the pandemic.

If awarded, there is a 10% match of \$16,487.31. This will be covered by the New Haven Fire Department's Capital Budget. We thank you for your continued support of New Haven's Emergency Responders during this challenging time.
