Dear President Walker-Myers,

On Behalf of the Office of Emergency Management, I am submitting for your consideration and approval a resolution giving the Mayor of New Haven permission to apply for and accept the 2020 FEMA Port Security Grant. We respectfully request your honorable board's approval.

Previous Port Security Grants have allowed the City to increase security in the port, through the purchase of cameras, additional training for our first responders and maintenance and support of our marine vessel.

With the 2020 three-year Port Security Grant, we hope to receive federal funding of \$316,000 to continue maintenance and support for the Marine 1 Vessel as well as a maintenance contract to support and fix New Haven Port related cameras. The three-year camera contract will cover the cost of repairs, annual software upgrades, support of milestone servers, camera factory repairs and lens cleaning.

If awarded, there is a match of 25%. The City plans to utilize funds from 20/21 FY CAO Capital Budget allocation of Rolling Stock as well as the General IT budget.

The total match is \$79,000. \$75,000 will be taken from IT and \$4,000 will be from CAO rolling stock.
