## Minutes

Alder Ellen Cupo, Chair, called the public hearing to order at 8:05 p.m.

1. ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT OF THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN SECTION 42.6 CONCERNING THE RESPONSIBLE AND EQUITABLE REGULATION OF ADULT USE CANNABIS TO ADD THE 'BE' ZONE TO SECTION 42.6(C)1 AND 42.6(C)2.

## PUBLIC TESTIMONY

Nathaniel Hougrand, Deputy Director of Zoning, 95 Court Street, presented and spoke in support of this item. Discussed how this was adding the BE zone to the adult use cannabis ordinance to correct it to allow cannabis use in the BE zone, as it was inadvertently left out originally.

In response to Alder Furlow, Mr. Hougrand confirmed this zone change would not affect the zoning of the Sound School.

In response to Alder Marchand, Mr. Hougrand confirmed new definitions were not being added, and the only changes to the ordinance are to sections 42.6(c)1 and 42.6(c)2.

In response to Alder Sabin, Mr. Hougrand confirmed the area this ordinance amendment affects.

Mark Sklarz, Attorney at Green & Sklarz, LLC, representing the owner of the old Long Wharf Theater, and representative spoke in support of this item.

## COMMITTEE ACTION

Alder Marchand moved item # 1, seconded by Alder Morrison. All of the Alders spoke in favor of the item. The motion was unanimously approved, and the item passed.

Alder Marchand moved to close the public hearing, seconded by Alder Morrison. The motion was unanimously approved at 8:25 p.m.
