Meeting Minutes

Alder Hamilton, called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m., September 14, 2020 via webinar. Present were Alds. Hamilton, Marchand, Santiago, DeCola, Morrison, Walker-Myer, Festa, Furlow, E. Rodriguez, Hurt, and Decker. Also present was Alder Roth.

Michael Gormany, Director of Management & Budget, Chet Sawicki, from IT, Scott Jackson & Mark DeCola, from Parks & Public Works, and Dr. Dalal, CSA Administrator, and Patricia King, Corporation Counsel, came before the committee. Mr. Gormany spoke on the ordinance amendment. Mr. Sawicki, Mark DeCola, and Dr. Dala, also spoke on the changes they were requesting.

Alder Marchand said that the request also was for a new position in IT. Mr. Gormany said there was, and he explained why.

Alder Marchand asked about the change in position in the CSA of Special Project Director and the current employee in the Project Manager position. Mr. Gormany said that this individual was aware of the possibility of his not getting the new position and that he would no longer have a job.

Alder Marchand asked if the new Special Project Director required higher coordination skills. Dr. Dala said that it did.

Alder Marchand asked how the new Deputy Corporation Counsel position work with the department assigned. Ms. King explained how this would work and was needed.

Alder Festa asked Ms. King for the structure of the Corporation Counsel office. Ms. King explained the setup of the department.

No further questions were asked.

Alder Hamilton asked three times if there was anyone from the public who wished to testify on this item. No one came forward,

Michael Gormany, Director of Management & Budget, Dr. Dala, CSA, and Carlos Sosa, Fresh Start came before the committee. Mr. Gormany spoke about why the funding was needed. Mr. Sosa gave a power point presentation on the Fresh start program. Dr. Dalal also spoke about this program.

Alder Marchand asked them how they planned to spend the money. Both Mr. Sosa and Dr Dalal explained how the money would be spent.

Alder Walker-Myer asked how much, approximately, would the Fresh Start contract cost. Mr. Sosa said about 80 thousand dollars. Dr. Dala also spoke on this.

Alder Walker-Myer asked if any other program could be used to help set up this program. Dr. Dala went over the other programs.

Alder festa asked if the positions used for this program were filled during the last budget. Mr. Gormany said that they were.

Michael Gormany, Director of Management & Budget, came before the committee. Mr. Gormany said that he was going to go over the May financial report because it was the latest report. Mr. Gormany spoke on the report.

Alder Marchand asked when the FEMA reimbursement money was expected. Mr.

Gormany said he didn't know but it should be soon.

Alder festa asked how many people applied for the deferral. Mike told the committee that he didn't know for sure because some people were automatically enrolled.

Alder festa asked if they needed to do anything to get additional funding from the State. Mr. Gormany said they were working this out and he didn't know for sure at this time.

Alder Festa asked if Mr. Gormany would send them preliminary numbers for COVID 19 expenses. Mr. Gormany said that he would.

Alder decker asked if they were planning a pilot program. Dr. Dalal said they were.

Alder Decker asked if they had been in contact Yale-New Haven Hospital about this. Dr. Dala said they had not.

Alder Hamilton asked three times if there was anyone from the public who wished to testify on this item. No one came forward.

Alder Festa asked how much the city had spent and what have we done. Mr. Zinn explained the work that had been done. Mr. Gormany said he would get back with better information.

Alder Rodriguez asked where the money came and what was the use. Mr. Gormany said that the funs had been appropriated in earlier capital funds.
