Meeting Minutes

Alder Hamilton, called the workshop to order at 6:04 p.m., May 13, 2021 via webinar. Present were Alds. Hamilton, Marchand, Santiago, DeCola, Morrison, Walker-Myer, Festa, Furlow, E. Rodriguez, and Decker. Also in attendance were Alders Sabin, Roth, Santana, Douglass, Singh, Winters, C. Rodriguez, and Antunes.

*Finance Committee to hold a public meeting to approve the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget.* 

Michael Gormany, Director of Management & Budget, came before the committee to speak about the proposed technical amendments to the budget. He went over the list for the committee.

#### Committee action

1. On a motion from Marchand, seconded by Santiago, to move items 10 through 13 favorably. The committee voted by voice vote to approve the requests from the Special Service Districts.

2. On a motion by Marchand, seconded by DeCola, to move items 6 through 9 favorably. The committee voted by voice vote to approve the budget requests for the Enterprise Funds.

3. On a motion by Marchand, seconded by Santiago, to move items 1 through 5 for discussion and vote.

Alder Marchand, seconded by Santiago, made a motion to approve the technical amendments. The committee voted by voice vote to approve these amendments.

On a motion by Marchand, seconded by Santiago, to approve amendments of reducing the Board of Education budget by \$1.5 million and adding \$1 million dollars to Expenditure Reserves and \$500,000 to Various Organizations for; \$100,000 for Job Training Outreach funds; \$100,000 for Community Policing Forum funds; \$100,000 for Affordable Housing studies; \$100,000 for Health Engagement fund; and \$100,000 for Environmental Education funds.

Alder Walker-Myers spoke in favor of this amendment.

The committee voted by voice vote to approve these amendments.

Alder Festa, made a motion, seconded by Marchand, to reduce the CERF and P&F pensions by \$500,000. There was a discussion by the committee about this amendment.

The committee voted by voice vote, yes: Alder Festa, No's Alders Hamilton, Marchand, Santiago, DeCola, Morrison, Walker-Myer, Furlow, E. Rodriguez, and Decker. The amendment failed.

Alder festa made a motion to reduce the Board of education by 1.5 million for the budget gap. There was no second and the amendment failed.

Alder Festa, seconded by Marchand, made a motion to amend the Fees by changing the Noise violation from \$100 to \$150. The committee voted by voice vote, yes: Alder Festa, No's Alders Hamilton, Marchand, Santiago, DeCola, Morrison, Walker-Myer, Furlow, E. Rodriguez, and Decker. The amendment failed.

On a motion by Marchand, seconded by DeCola to approve the budget items 1 through 5, as amended Appropriation Ordinance #1, #2 Tax and Levy Ordinance, #3 General Obligation Bonds, #4 General Obligation Tax Anticipation Notes and/or General Obligation Grant Anticipation Notes, and #5 ordinance Amendment Section 17-201 of the General Code of Ordinances Authorizing additions and changes in permits, Licenses and User Fees.

The committee voted by voice vote, yes: Alders Hamilton, Marchand, Santiago, DeCola, Morrison, Walker-Myer, Furlow, E. Rodriguez, and Decker No Alder Festa. The motion passed.

At 7:30 PM, on a motion by Marchand, seconded by Furlow, to close the meeting.
